- Report directly to the Operations Manager and follow daily plans.
- Set up panels, gates, and seating before events and clean up after.
- Act as a welcoming and helpful contact for renters and guests.

- Understanding of farm machinery, cattle, rodeos, and public events.
- Ability to safely run a tractor, skid steer, quad, and implements.
- Sharp problem-solving skills and a knack for fixing mechanical or building issues.
- Motivation to work independently while following the guidance of the Operations Manager.
- Willingness to look after indoor/outdoor horse pens and automatic waterers.
- Physical strength to do heavy lifting and work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Availability to work flexible hours, including weekends and evenings for events
